



"The Battle Hymn of the Republic", also known as "Mine Eyes Have Seen the Glory", is a song by American writer Julia Ward Howe using the tune from the song "John Brown's Body".

Howe's more famous lyrics were written in 1861, and first published in 1862..

Since that time, it has become an extremely popular and well-known folk song .

Judy Garland performed this song on her television show in 1963 and Johnny Cash performed it on his show in 1969.

The Beach Boys recorded the song in 1974 and Andy Williams experienced commercial success in 1968.

Whitney Houston performed this song live.

"An American Trilogy" is a song arranged by country songwriter Mickey Newbury and made popular by Elvis Presley.

It is a medley of three 19th century songs—"Dixie", "All My Trials" and "The Battle Hymn of the Republic".
