D'ye ken John Peel (song)

An English /Scottish Folk song from the 1800's

Most Brits will know it but its in because like many strong tunes it has survived for centuries and crossed many genres . However they might be surprised that their American cousins are very very familiar with it since it became the 1939 jingle "Pepsi Cola hits the spot"

American composer Austen Herbert Croom-Johnson (British born) imported the tune, "D'ye ken John Peel," and scored it for a 1939 jingle, "Pepsi-Cola Hits the Spot"
