"Montego Bay" was written and performed by Bobby Bloom .It was a top 10 hit in 1970 on both sides of the Atlantic, reaching No. 3 on the UK Singles Chart and No. 8 on the US Billboard Hot 100

It resurfaced in 1980 and took Jon Stevens to No 1 in New Zealand Various recordings since have charted including Amazulu in 1986 (Uk US Canada)

It pops up about every 10 years being re-aired by people like James Last.

Best of all it's a great party song . Ideal for a sing song
