

Play this with some feeling, but not *too* slow. The single brushes near the end benefit from a bit of a flourish.. Make your banjo ring !!!!!

This is a song by the Beatles from their 1966 album Revolver. It was also issued on a double A-side single, paired with "Yellow Submarine".

It topped singles charts in Australia, Belgium, Canada and New Zealand.

In 2000, Mojo ranked "Eleanor Rigby" at number 19 on its list of "The 100 Greatest Songs of All Time".

In BBC Radio 2's millennium poll, listeners voted it as one of the top 100 songs of the twentieth century.

It was ranked at number 137 on Rolling Stone's list "The 500 Greatest Songs of All Time" in 2004. "Eleanor Rigby" was inducted into the NARSA Grammy Hall of Fame in 2002.

It is astonishing how many artists have been determined to record their own versions. Great artists like Ray Charles , Aretha Franklin and Big Country. There are dozens more right up to Cody Fry in the last 2 years. Now that's a "pop" song.
