




# (Now and then theres) A FOOL SUCH AS I gDGBD

Since that original Snow version, "Fool Such as I" has been recorded by artists such as Jo Stafford, Elvis Presley, Bob Dylan and Petula Clark

It has been number one in four national hit Charts.
