A BIT TRICKY

Takes you up to 9th fret in line 3.

At the end of line 3 , fret the 4's and 5's and then the 7's in line 4 all with your first finger so you can stretch to the 9 & 10 with your third and little finger. (Practice that for a bit)

On the bottom line there is a slide followed by pulloff

Do the 7-5 pulloff with your little finger.

If you struggle, just play the 7 and drop thumb the open 5th string

American folk song first recorded by Vernon Dalhart in 1925.
