





The song was a number 1 hit in Australia when released on a single there in 1966. In the United Kingdom, the BPI awarded the song a silver certificate for sales exceeding 200,000 units.

The song has been covered by many artists, including Waylon Jennings, Cilla Black, and Buddy Rich.
