Guitar tablature for "Don't Be Cruel" by Elvis Presley, arranged by O. Blackwell. The piece is in 4/4 time and G major. The tablature is written on three systems of six-line staves. Within a few weeks "Hound Dog" had risen to #2 on the charts but soon after was overtaken by "Don't Be Cruel" which went to no1 on all three main charts;
Between them, both songs remained at #1 on the Pop chart for a run of 11 weeks
