Written by McCartney "Ob-La-Di, Ob-La-Da" was released on "The Beatles" album in 1968 .It was issued as a single in many countries but not in the UK and the United States. In 1976, Capitol Records issued the song as a single in the US.

It topped singles charts in West Germany, Austria, Switzerland, Australia, New Zealand and Japan .It earned an Ivor Novello Award. The record achieved sales of over 50,000 copies, being eligible for a Gold Disc.

A recording by Marmalade, released in late 1968, became the most commercially successful of all Beatles cover versions.

It reached number 1 in the UK Singles Chart in January 1969 selling around half a million in the UK, and a million copies worldwide.

Play it lively with a steady rhythm.The "rests" are a bit tricky. Play the whole thing slowly until you get the gist of it. The lyrics will help you sort out the tune .

The first 4 bars are purely "intro" and set the basic rhythm.

Note the "first ending" "1" . where the "repeat dots" take you back to the second line , and then , on the second run,ignore ending bar "1" and play into "ending bar 2" and then through to the end.
