The single by B. J. Thomas reached No. 1 on charts in the United States, Canada and Norway, and reached No. 38 in the UK Singles Chart. It topped the Billboard Hot 100 for four weeks in January 1970. The song also spent seven weeks atop the Billboard adult contemporary chart.

It sold over 2 million copies by March 1970.

When the movie came out it hit hugely and sold about 200,000 to 300,000 records a day and continued selling for about three years.

Amongst the many versions recorded by other artists it was covered in French by French singer Sacha Distel. It reached number 10 in 1970 in the UK Singles Chart. Distel also recorded a version with the original English lyrics, and another in Italian.
