Released in 1955 it soon became a popular modern folk song.

The Kingston Trio version came out in 1961 and entered the Billboard charts.

In 1962 Peter Paul and Mary and Marlene Dietrich issued covers .

The Dietrich version entered the German charts.

In 1963 many artists recorded their versions including The Searchers, The Springfields, Bobby Darin and Roy Orbison.

In 1964 Vera Lynn and Four Seasons had a go.

The Bluegrass boys Lester Flatt and Earl Scruggs recorded it in 1968.

There were endless 1970's versions including Earth wind and Fire and Dolly Parton.

There were even several foreign versions in Germany(2014) Taiwan (2012) and Russia (1998). That's how good the actual tune is!!
