Scott English and Larry Weiss and first released as a single in March 1967

by English band The Attack, then a few days later by Jeff Beck.

The Attack's version failed , while Beck's recording reached the Top 20 of the singles chart in his native Britain in both 1967 and 1972, becoming his biggest solo hit. It never really did anything in the States.
